Risk management is often seen as a reactive, audit driven mechanism, seen as an administrative burden. With warnings, manufacturing failures having a severe financial impact, the question many people are asking are there alternatives? As much as 90% of risk is driven by "soft" mechanisms (i.e. people). Risk is created and managed by individual and collective attitudes and behaviours, yet why is it that so little focus and attention is given to managing people? Experience suggests that a lot more investment at the outset in the "people continuum" and true profiling does help to proactively manage risk.
